What is financial resilience?

Financial resilience is the ability to bounce back from life events that impact on income and/or assets.

Some financially adverse events, unemployment, socio economic status, catastrophic disaster, pandemic, trauma, divorce, disability, and health problems affect people individually.

The ability to bounce back from adversity is difficult, however with grass roots support - goals can be achieved.





Lithgow – Economic Barriers to Financial Resilience

- SEIFA Lithgow CBD 923
- SEIFA Bowenfels Social Housing 793
- 16.5% are in living in poverty
- 34.12% in rental stress
- 8.5% unemployment rate
- 23.9% single parents
- Median household weekly income \$830 with 35.8% below \$650
- 18.4% with a higher education level above Cert III
